**VA COVID-19 Mass Vaccination Station  
Scheduled for Tomorrow in Kearney  
Now Open to Walk-Ins for Eligible Veterans**

OMAHA, Neb. – VA Nebraska-Western Iowa Health Care System has opened tomorrow’s COVID-19 Veterans Mass Vaccination Station at the Kearney Armed Forces Reserve Center for walk-in appointments for eligible Veterans in the Central Nebraska area.

The Veterans Mass Vaccination Station is open to all eligible Veterans, regardless of age, who meet established VA eligibility criteria. The Kearney Armed Forces Reserve Center is located at 5710 Airport Road in Kearney, Neb.

Eligible Veterans who desire to receive a vaccination but have not yet been scheduled for an appointment can walk-in to the Veterans Mass Vaccination Station at the Kearney Armed Forces Reserve Center between 9 a.m. and noon.

The Kearney COVID-19 Veterans Mass Vaccination Station is part of VA Nebraska-Western Iowa Health Care System’s ongoing effort to provide COVID-19 vaccinations to eligible area Veterans who desire to receive the vaccine. VA Nebraska-Western Iowa Health Care System is partnering in this effort with the Nebraska National Guard, which is allowing the VA to use its local readiness centers.
